Official RoHS Compliancy Declaration

- 1. The object of the declaration is to inform distributors, industrial users, and clients of ACL's current status in the process of conforming to RoHS 3.
 - a. REGULATION (EC) EU 2015/863 concerning the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment ("RoHS Directive").
 - **b.** The information presented is based on ACL, Inc.'s understanding of the directives and ACL, Inc.'s knowledge of the materials that are used in the products as of the date of disclosure which is based on information provided by third parties (our raw material vendors).
- **2. Requirements:** RoHS3 "**Restriction on Hazardous Substances**" restricts the use of the following harmful substances [materials] found in electrical and electronic products:
 - 1. Cadmium (Cd) <0.01% of component weight =<100 PPM
 - 2. Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI) <0.10% of component weight =<1,000 ppm
 - 3. Lead (Pb) <0.10% of component weight =<1000 ppm
 - 4. Mercury (Hg) <0.10% of component weight =<1,000 ppm
 - 5. Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBBs) 0.10% of component weight =< 1,000 ppm
 - 6. Polybrominated Diphenylethers (PBDEs) <0.10% of component weight =< 1,000 ppm
 - 7. Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) = <1000 ppm
 - 8. Butyl benzyl phthalate (BPP) = <1000 ppm*
 - 9. Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) = <1000 ppm*
 - 10. Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) < 1000 ppm*
 - 11. Hexabromocyclododecane (HBCDD) (a brominated Flame Retardant)*
 - *Anticipated updates: ACL, Inc. products does not include the listed candidates.
 - **a.** All chemical products manufactured by ACL Inc. featured on website and pricelist including **General Purpose Staticide** meet the requirements of the RoHS Directive.
 - **b.** To our knowledge, provided for by raw material suppliers, category 9 industrial monitoring & control instruments are RoHS3 compliant with the exception of ACL 350 Static Locator.
 - c. To our knowledge, provided for by raw material suppliers, ACL, Inc. does not use Annex IV exemptions.
