




Transfer Characteristics




On-Resistance vs. Drain Current








Gate Charge




Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Threshold Voltage

On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature




Safe Operating Area




