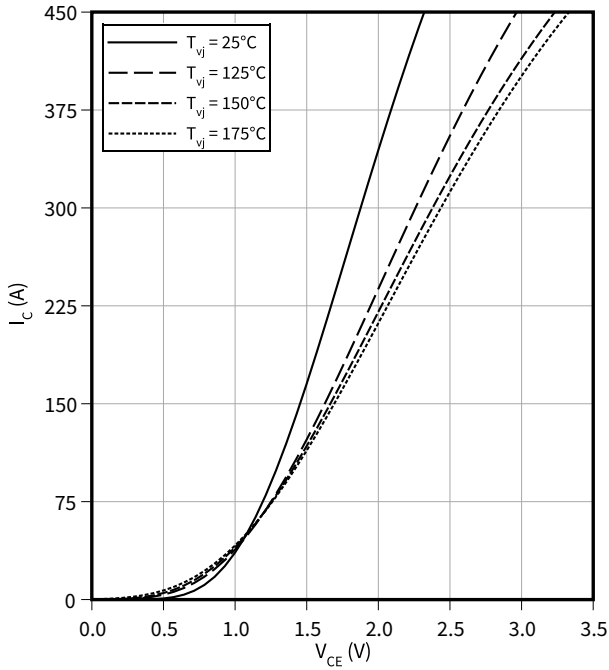

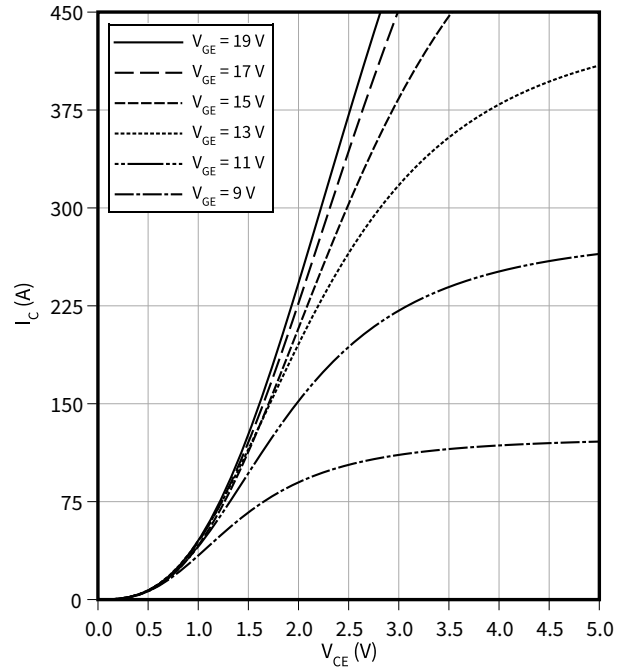

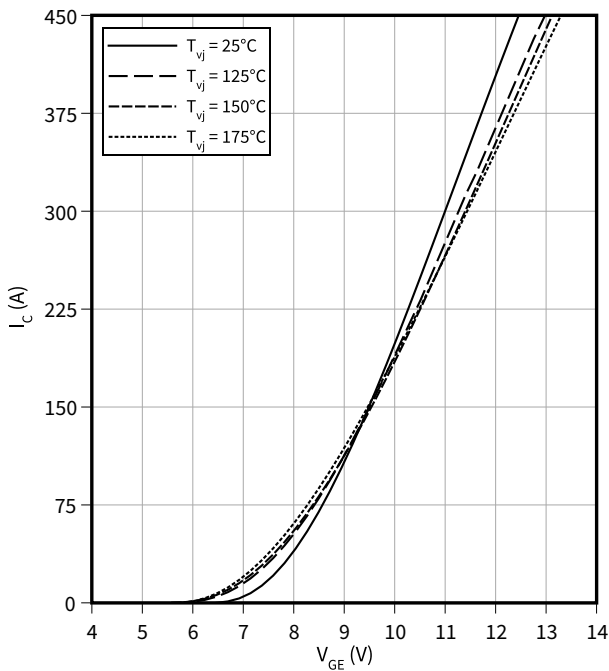

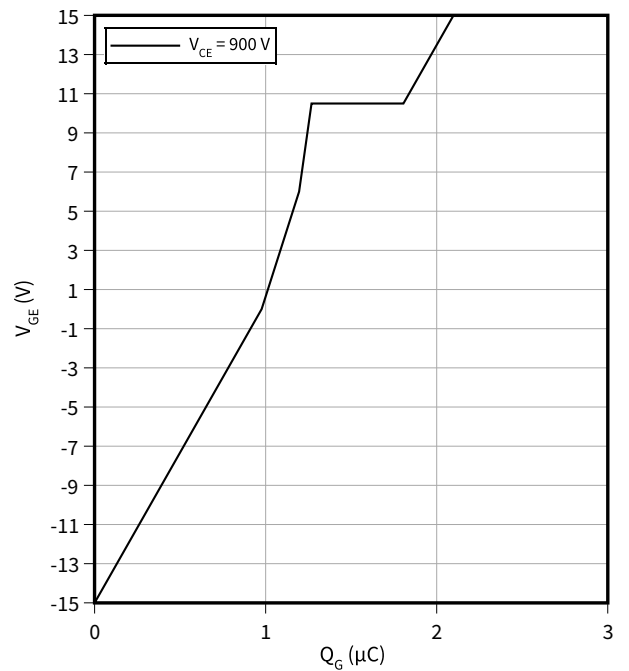

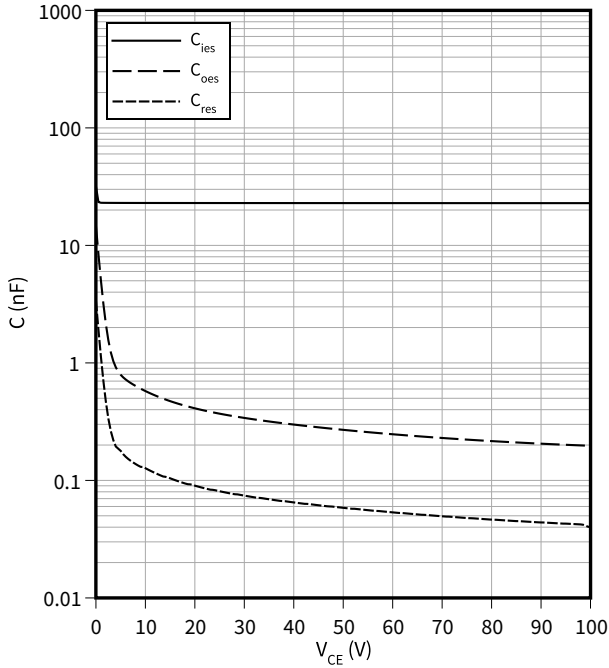

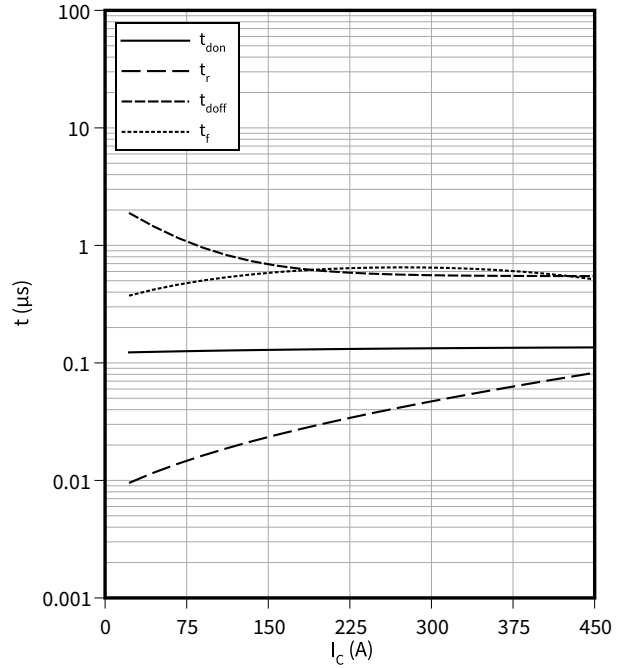

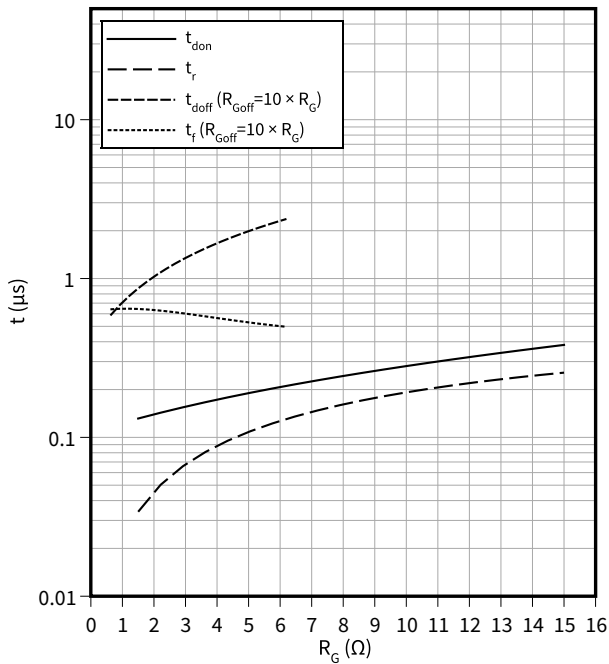

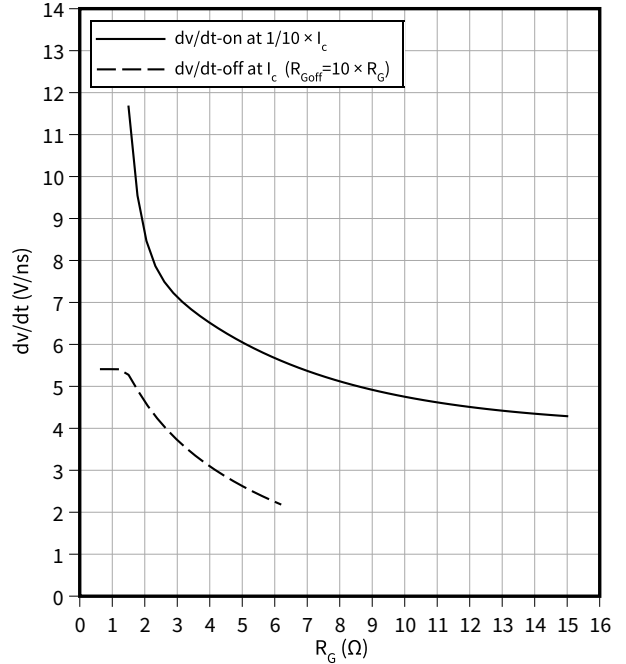

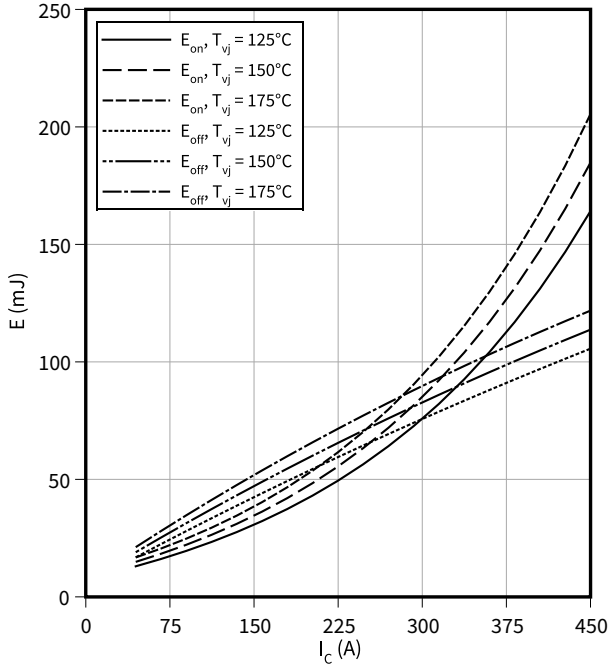

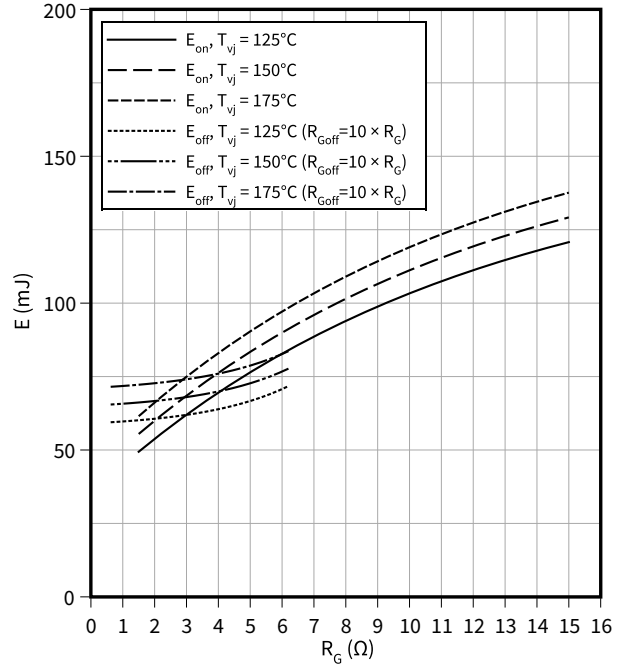

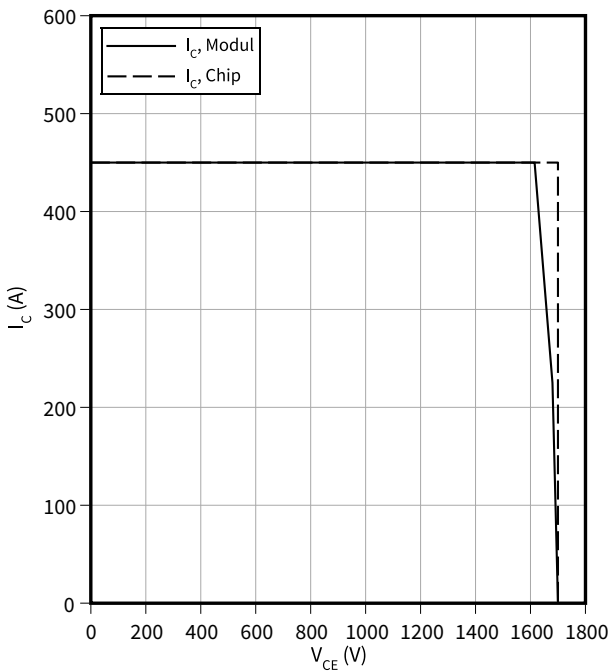

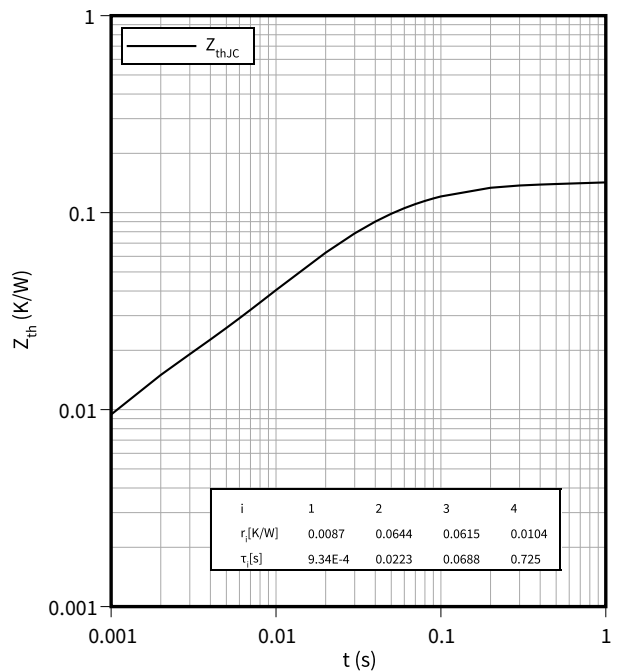

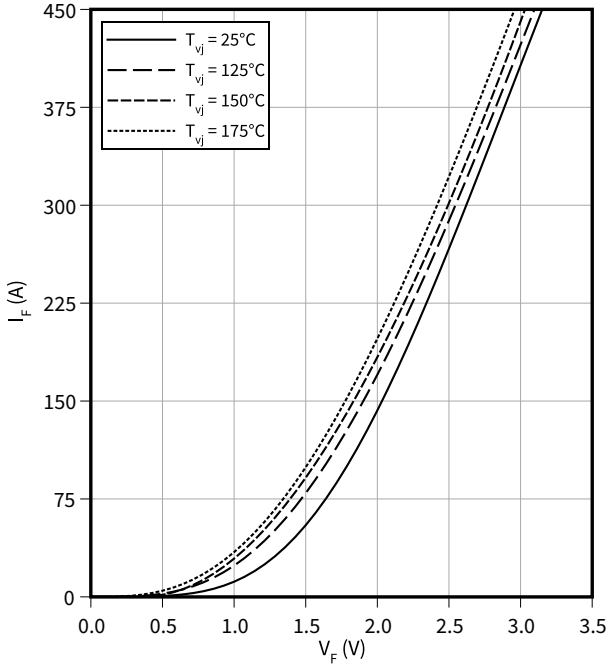

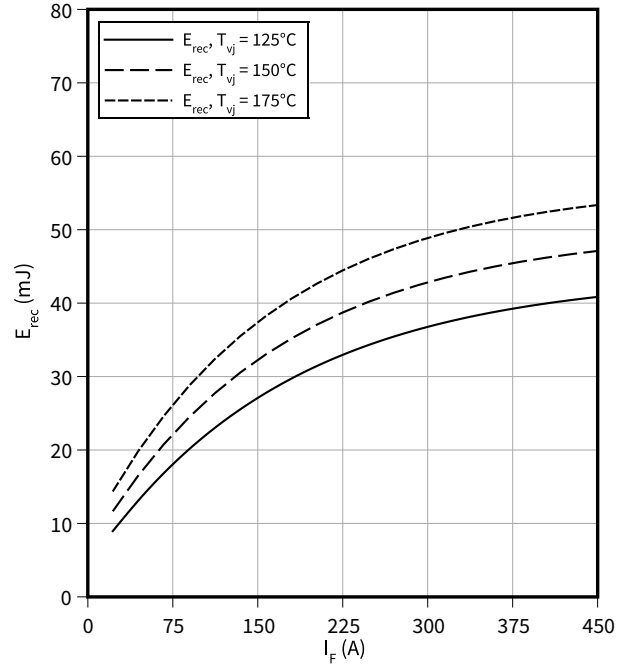

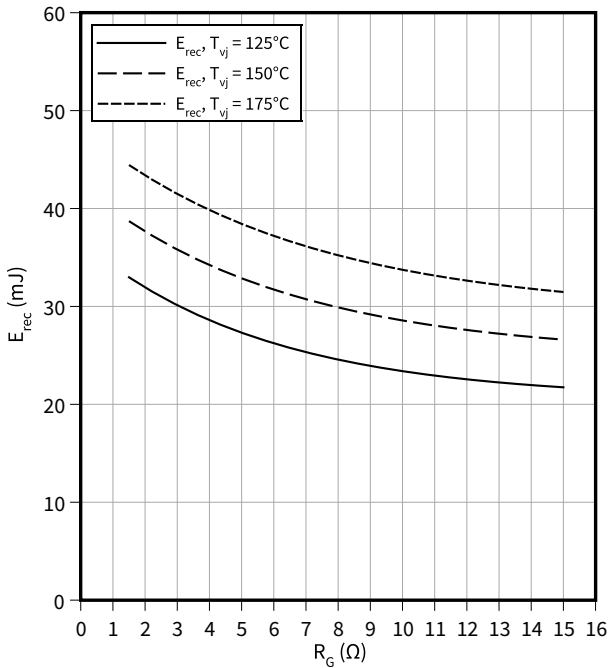

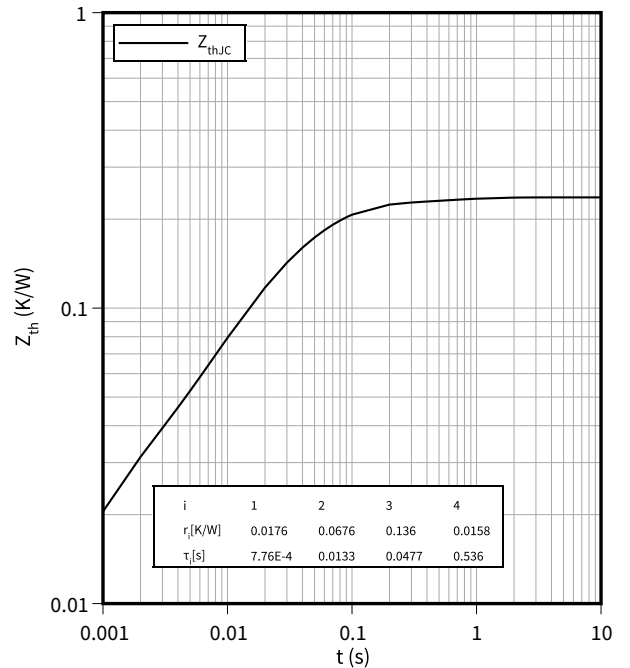

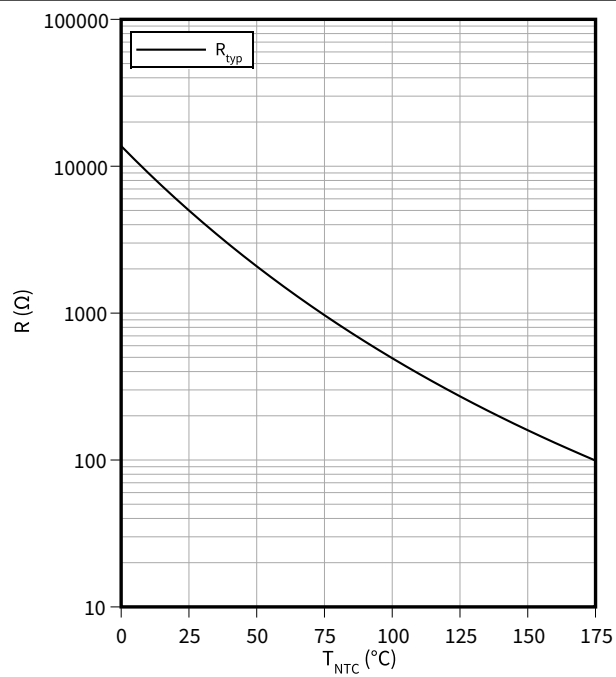
Transient thermal impedance, Diode, Inverter

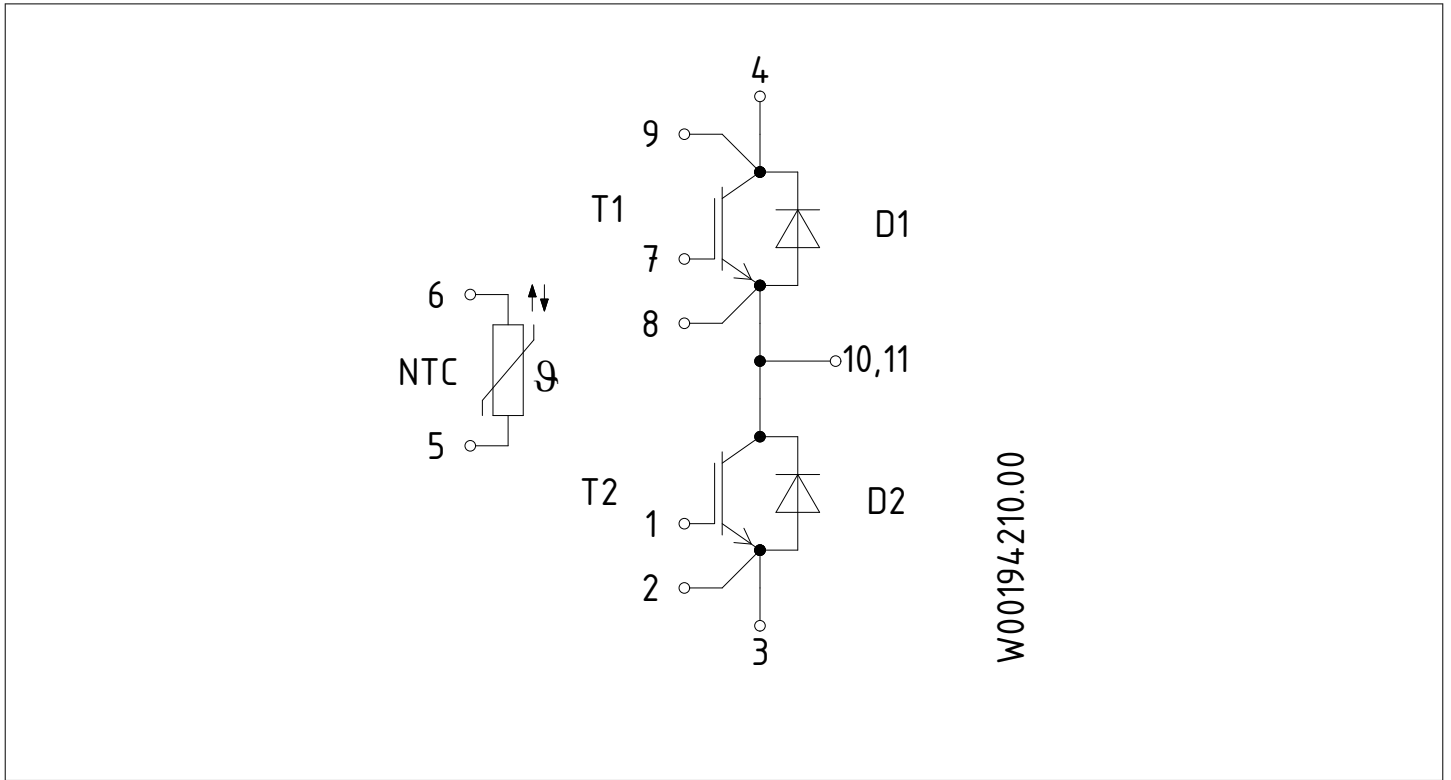

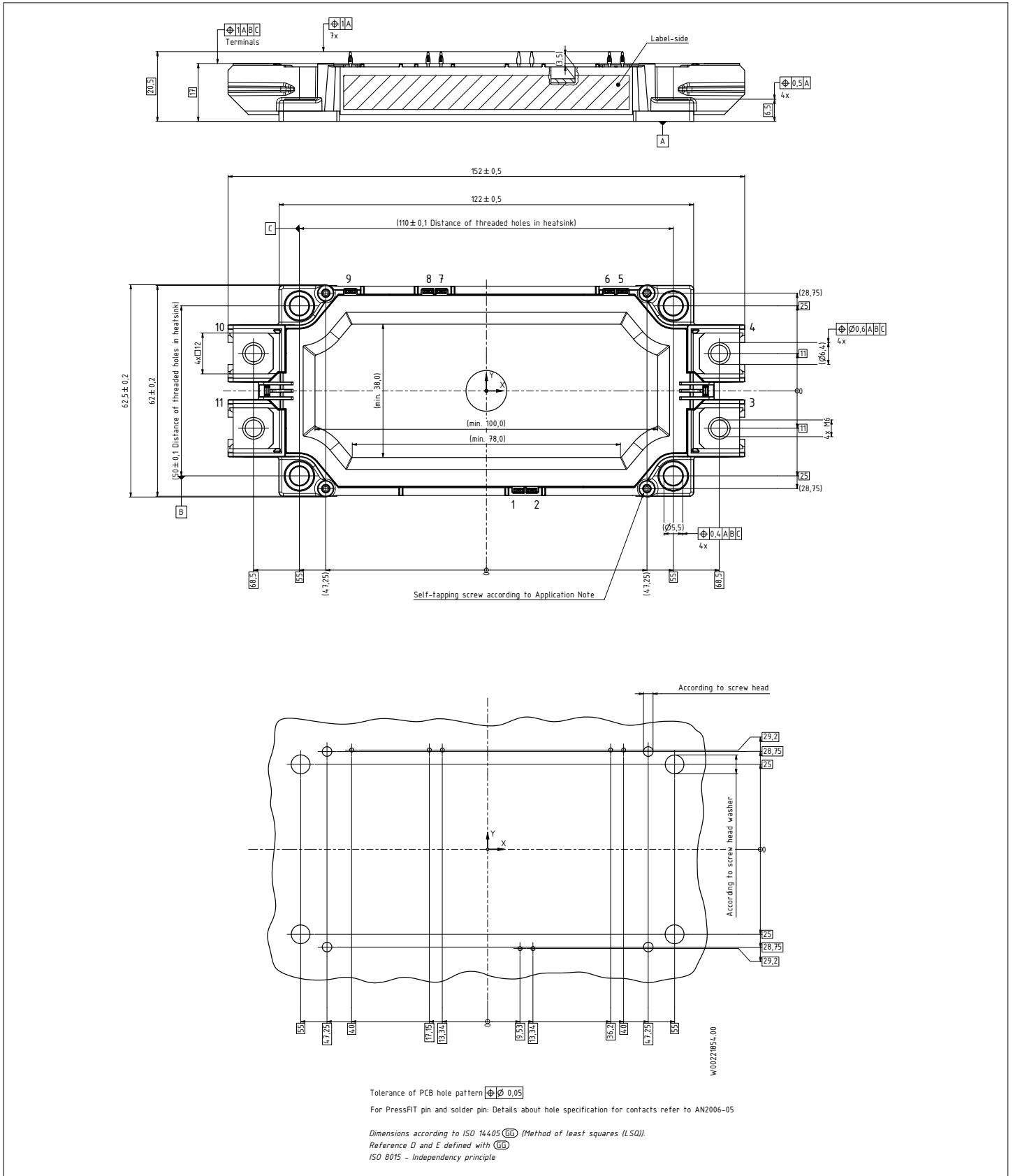

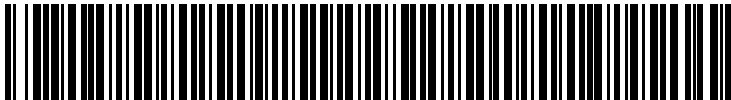
