

# 74LVC16373A; 74LVCH16373A

16-bit D-type transparent latch with 5 V tolerant inputs/outputs; 3-state

## 1. General description

The 74LVC16373A and 74LVCH16373A are 16-bit D-type transparent latches with 3-state outputs. The devices can be used as two 8-bit transparent latches or a single 16-bit transparent latch. The devices feature two latch enables (1LE and 2LE) and two output enables ( $1\overline{OE}$  and  $2\overline{OE}$ ), each controlling 8-bits. When nLE is HIGH, data at the inputs enter the latches. In this condition the latches are transparent, a latch output will change each time its corresponding D-input changes. When nLE is LOW the latches store the information that was present at the inputs a set-up time preceding the HIGH-to-LOW transition of nLE. A HIGH on  $n\overline{OE}$  causes the outputs to assume a high-impedance OFF-state. Operation of the  $n\overline{OE}$  input does not affect the state of the latches. Inputs can be driven from either 3.3 V or 5 V devices. This feature allows the use of these devices as translators in mixed 3.3 V and 5 V environments.

Schmitt-trigger action at all inputs makes the circuit tolerant of slower input rise and fall times.

This device is fully specified for partial power down applications using  $I_{OFF}$ . The  $I_{OFF}$  circuitry disables the output, preventing the potentially damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

Bus hold on the data inputs eliminates the need for external pull-up resistors to hold unused inputs.

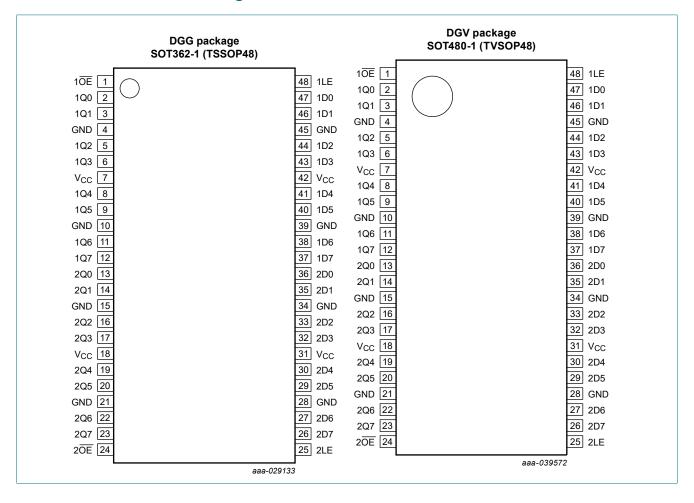

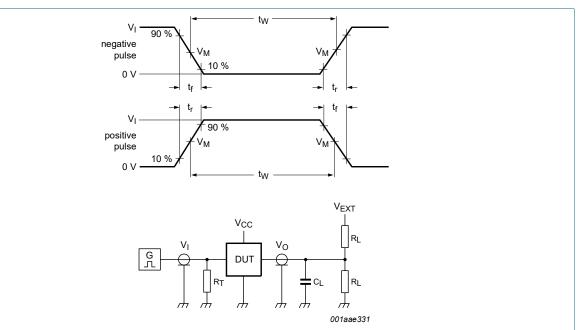

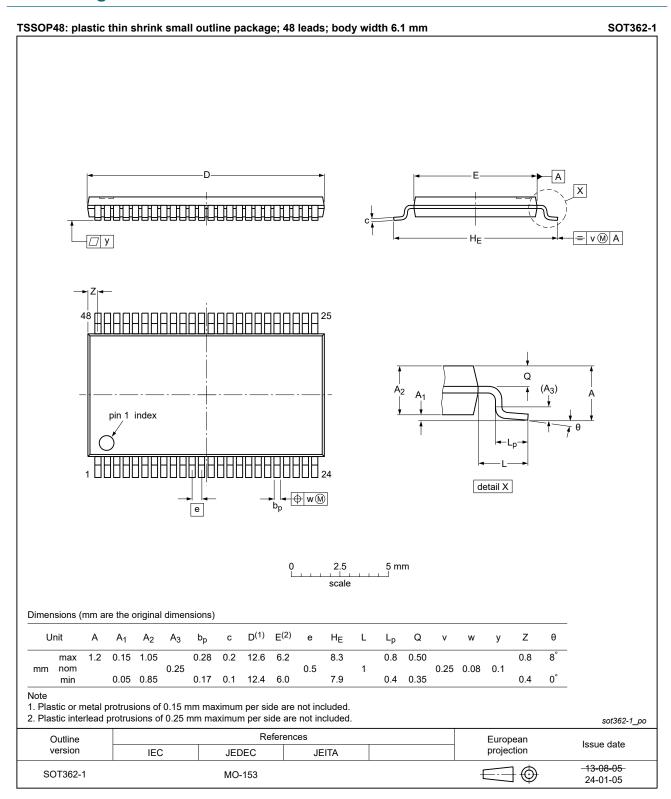


Fig. 10. Package outline SOT362-1 (TSSOP48)

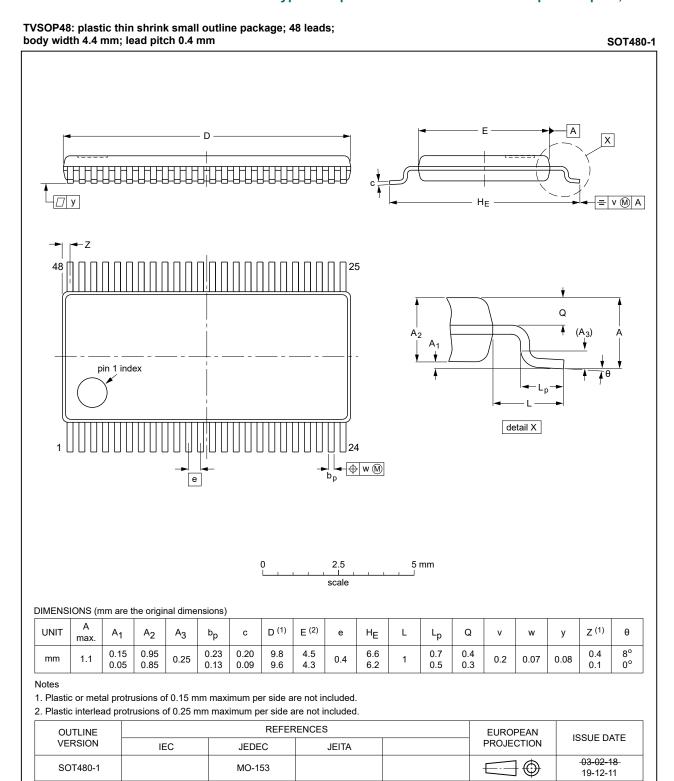


Fig. 11. Package outline SOT480-1 (TVSOP48)
