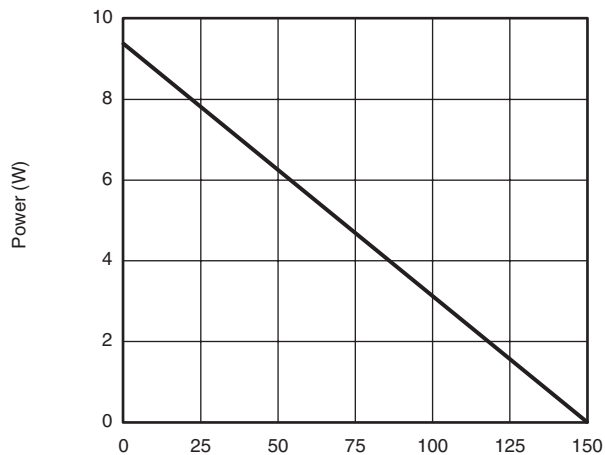
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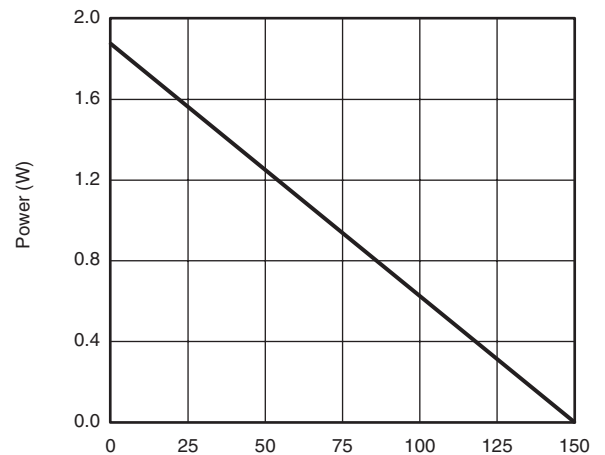
$T_C$  - Case Temperature (°C)

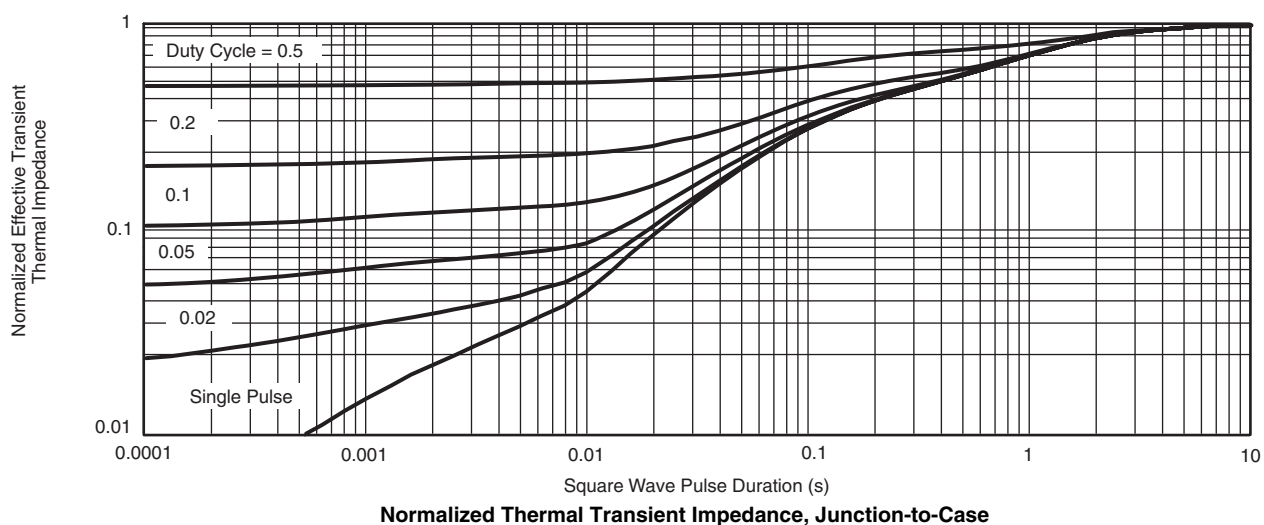
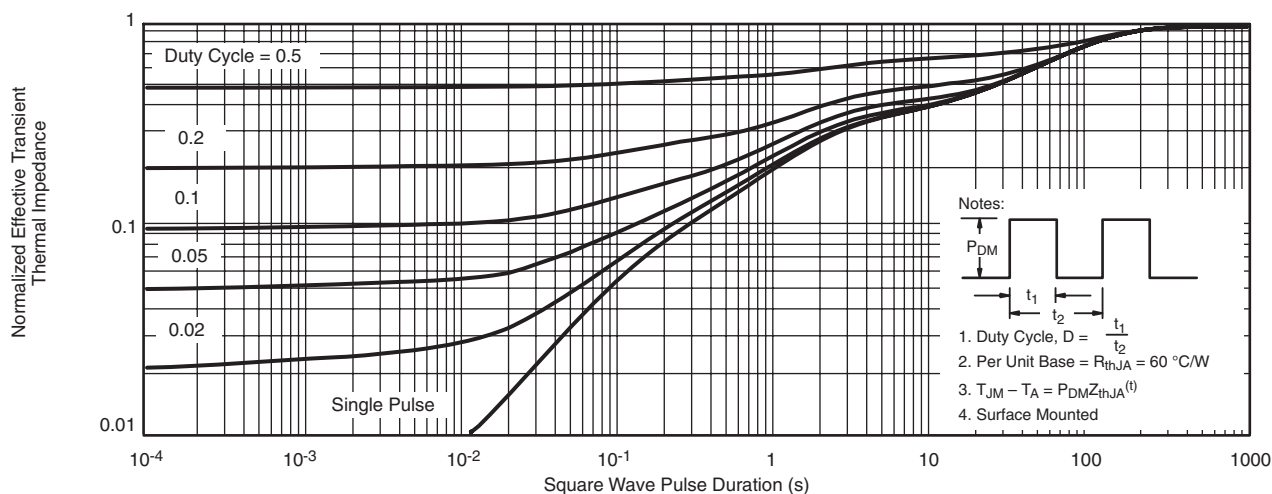
**Power, Junction-to-Foot**
