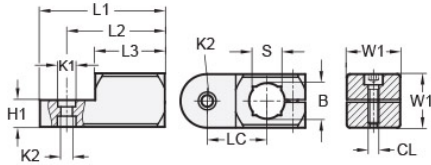
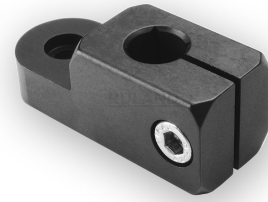




## MT20-CCSWV-30-AN

### Description

Ruland MT20-CCSWV-30-AN is a swivel clamp joint with a thru hole for 20mm round or 16mm square tube, M6 clamp screw, 15mm base height, 30mm width and height, and 70mm overall length. It is designed to fit with MT20 swivel clamp bases, MT20 clamp connectors and mounting blocks, and MT20 round and square tubes. When combined with a swivel bases or attachment clamp joints, it is an ideal articulating mounting solution for screens, sensors, reflectors, plexiglass machine guards, and other components that require frequent adjustments. The vertical bore is parallel to the swivel axis. An MT20-SWALK-M6-30 adjustable clamping handle can be used to join it to other Ruland swivel components or tubes for rapid repositioning without the use of tools. This part is aluminum with a black anodized finish for added corrosion resistance when compared to unplated types. MT20-CCSWV-30-AN is manufactured by Otto Ganter, inventoried by Ruland, and RoHS3 compliant.
